the places that God has moved in my life. He has moved me in such a way that I began to seek him years ago. He has moved me to go and do missions overseas. He has moved me to further my schooling. He has moved me to serve him in ministry. Yet, in many ways, these really are not the highlights of the places he has moved.

Often times I feel like I/we get caught up in the big moves of our lives so much that we fail to recognize the real moves in the day to day: stopping to talk and help a person stuck on the side of the road . . . writing the card that we keep thinking about . . . calling the person we haven't talked to in ages . . . visiting with a neighbor we see daily but rarely talk to . . . actually talking to the cashier instead of a phone, and genuinely caring about what they have to say . . . telling those around us just what they mean to us, instead of assuming they know what they mean to us . . . spending time asking God to fix things instead of talking to everyone about how the world is falling apart. In essence, the real moves are expressing the love that God has placed in our heart.

When we look at the Bible, often times, we read about characters of the faith who appear larger than life. We see the highlights of their life and fail to understand that their faith wasn't just in the event, but in the day to day life we heard nothing about.

I have now been with BCC for a few weeks and have seen Christ in the day to day life of BCC. I have been invited into the life of the church regularly and have experienced the joy of the faithful. You will truly recognize the highlights when they come if you continue to share the love Christ has placed in your heart in the day to day.
